INDIAN TEA EXPORT TO IRAN

1606. SHRI JAGADISH SHETTAR:

Will the Minister of **COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY** (वाणिज्य और उद्योग मंत्री) be pleased to state :-

- (a) whether the Iran-Israel Conflict halted the Indian Tea Export to Iran, which has been the significant Importer from India; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the steps being taken in speeding up the delivery in the prevailing situation?

(a) & (b): No reports of Indian tea exports being impacted due to the Iran-Israel conflict have been received, rather Tea exports from India to Iran have grown from 29.62 million USD in 2023 to 40.81 million USD in 2024. Further, in the period January-June 2025, Tea exports to Iran stood at 23.21 million USD as against 20.38 million USD in the same period of previous year, showing an increase of 13.89 %.
