(a) to (c): The Union Budget 2025-26 announced the launch of Asset Monetization Plan 2025-30 to plough back Rs. 10 lakh crore to further accelerate the creation of infrastructure in the country.

Asset Monetisation Plan primarily includes linear assets such as highways, transmission lines, pipelines etc, which often span multiple states. The details of the assets to be monetized under Asset Monetisation Plan are maintained sector-wise, and state-wise or district-wise details are not maintained.
