(a) to (c): Indian Railways is wholly owned by Government of India. All zonal railways, Production units, workshops etc. are integral part of Indian railways. All assets like railway tracks, signaling system, rolling stocks etc. are under the ownership of Indian Railways only. Trains operations is the responsibility of Indian Railways.

Presently, there is no plan to privatise the Indian Railways.
