(a) to (e) NCC is a voluntary organization. There is no proposal to make NCC training compulsory. NCC is presently operational in 21,819 educational institutions throughout the country. To promote awareness regarding National Cadet Corps (NCC) among students and institutions, the officers of NCC Units visit educational institutions to provide awareness. In addition, NCC activities are also publicised through social media.
