Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of projects sanctioned under the Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY) in Karnataka since the inception of the scheme;
- (b) the present status of each of these projects, including timeline for completion, physical and financial progress along with the reasons for any delays, district-wise;
- (c) whether the upgraded institutions and new facilities under PMSSY in Karnataka have helped improve access to tertiary healthcare, and if so, the details of patient load, speciality services and medical education capacity created as a result;
- (d) whether any new proposals from the State of Karnataka are currently under consideration under PMSSY; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof alongwith the expected timeline for their approval and implementation ?

- (a) to (e) Under the Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY), in the State of Karnataka, three Government Medical Colleges (GMCs) have been upgraded on a Centre-State cost-sharing basis as per following details:

The upgraded super specialty facilities in these GMC's have strengthened tertiary healthcare by providing specialized services including Cardiology, Neurology, Plastic Surgery, Neurosurgery, Surgical Gastroenterology, Pediatric Surgery, Urology, Oncology, Nephrology.

In the current phase of PMSSY, there is no proposal under consideration for approval of any new facilities under the scheme in the State of Karnataka.
