325. DR. MANNA LAL RAWAT:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the number of farmers adopting natural and organic farming systems and the area of land under such systems in Udaipur Lok Sabha Constituency in Rajasthan, district-wise;
- (b) the details of the schemes under which financial assistance has been provided by the Government in Rajasthan for promotion of natural and organic farming systems during the last five years, district-wise;
- (c) whether the Government has increased or proposes to increase the existing incentives for farmers practicing natural and organic farming systems and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण राज्य मंत्री (SHRI RAMNATH THAKUR)

(a): Natural farming is being promoted through the National Mission on Natural Farming (NMNF). In Rajasthan 90,000 Ha with 2.25 lakh farmers have initiated natural farming.

Organic farming is promoted through the Paramparagat Krishi Vikas Yojana (PKVY) since 2015-16. Under PKVY, 1.485 lakh Ha area has been covered in Rajasthan with 2.17 lakh farmers.

Details of area covered and farmers benefitted through PKVY and NMNF in the Udaipur Parliamentary Constituency is as below:

(b) to (d): Under NMNF, an output based incentive of ₹4000/- per acre per year per farmer for 2 years (upto 1 acre per farmer) is provided to the farmers to practice natural farming, training, upkeep of livestock (preferably local breed)/ preparation of natural farming inputs including purchase of mixing & storage containers, purchase of natural farming inputs from Bio-input Resource Centers etc. Enrollment of farmers has commenced in Rajasthan under NMNF.

Under PKVY, financial assistance of ₹15,000 per Ha in 3 years is provided directly to farmers through Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) for on-farm and off-farm organic inputs. One farmer can avail assistance for a maximum of 2 Ha area under PKVY. The district wise details of financial assistance provided to farmers in Rajasthan under PKVY during the last five years is given at Annexure 1.

There is no proposal at present to change the existing incentives for farmers under NMNF and PKVY.
