- (a) the details of the total amount disbursed under Kala Sanskriti Vikas Yojana (KSVY) along with the number of schemes and projects supported during the last five financial years, year and State-wise including UT of Jammu and Kashmir particularly in Jammu district;
- (b) the details of the number of sub-schemes currently operational under the scheme and allocation of funds thereunder particularly in Jammu district; and
- (c) the quantum of financial assistance provided in the current cycle to voluntary Buddhist and Tibetan organisations under the specific component of the said scheme?

(a) Kala Sanskriti Vikas Yojana (KSVY) is an umbrella Scheme consisting 08 scheme components under which financial assistance is provided to eligible cultural organizations / individuals working in the field of performing arts across the country including the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir. The total amount disbursed under KSVY over the last five financial years is as under:
