Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a)whether it is true that pension is being provided to the workers in the unorganised sector under 'Pradhan Mantri Shram Yogi Maandhan Yojana' (PM-SYM);
- (b)if so, the details thereof along with eligibility criteria, contribution, procedure to get benefit and implementation process regarding the said scheme;
- (c)the details of the beneficiaries registered and benefitted across the Country since the inception of the said scheme, State/UT-wise; and
- (d)the details of the number of the workers registered and benefitted under the said scheme in Rajasthan, district-wise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SUSHRI SHOBHA KARANDLAJE)

(a) to (d): The Pradhan Mantri Shram Yogi Maan-dhan (PM-SYM) scheme was launched in February, 2019 in order to provide old age protection to the workers of unorganised sector. This is a voluntary and contributory pension scheme. Under the scheme, a monthly assured pension of Rs. 3000/- is provided to the unorganised workers after attaining the age of 60 years. The workers in the age group of 18 to 40 years whose monthly income is Rs. 15000/- or less and not a member of EPFO/ESIC/NPS (Govt. funded) are eligible to join the scheme. The monthly contribution amount ranges from Rs. 55/- to Rs. 200/-, depending upon the entry age of the beneficiary. Under the

scheme, 50% monthly contribution is payable by the beneficiary and equal matching contribution is paid by the Central Government. Enrolment in the Scheme is done through the Common Service Centres, with its network of about 4 lakh Centres across the country. Eligible unorganised workers can also self-enroll through visiting the portal www.maandhan.in.

The number of beneficiaries enrolled under the Pradhan Mantri Shram Yogi Maan-dhan (PM-SYM) scheme are 51,36,578 (including bulk registration of 5,06,603 beneficiaries) as on 10.07.2025. The State-wise number of beneficiaries enrolled across the country since inception is at Annexure-I.

The total number of registration under PM-SYM scheme in the State of Rajasthan is 1,48,005 (as on 10.07.2025). The districtwise details of the unorganised workers registered under the said scheme in Rajasthan is at Annexure-II.
