NEW TARGETS FOR EXPANSION OF PM-KISAN

4271. DR. KALANIDHI VEERASWAMY:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has set any new targets for expanding the coverage of the PMKISAN scheme in the current financial year;
- (b) the details of the total number of beneficiaries covered so far under the scheme, Statewise and the additional number proposed to be brought under the new target;
- (c) the total funds allocated, released and utilized under the scheme in the last three years, particularly for Tamil Nadu;
- (d) whether the Government has taken any steps to include tenant farmers, sharecroppers, and tribal farmers in the scheme's coverage; and
- (e) whether there is any proposal to increase the annual assistance amount under PM-KISAN in light of rising input costs and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

- (a): The PM-KISAN scheme is a central sector scheme launched in February 2019 by the Hon'ble Prime Minister to supplement the financial needs of farmers with cultivable land-holding. Under the scheme, a financial benefit of Rs 6,000/- per year is transferred in three equal instalments, into the Aadhaar seeded bank accounts of farmers through Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) mode. Under the PM-KISAN Scheme, cultivable landholding is primary eligibility criteria to receive benefit of the Scheme subject to certain exclusion criteria.

A farmer-centric digital infrastructure has ensured the benefits of the scheme reach all the farmers across the country without involvement of any intermediaries. Maintaining absolute transparency in registering and verifying beneficiaries, the Government of India has disbursed over Rs 3.90 lakh Cr. through 20 installments since inception of the Scheme. Currently there are no new targets for expanding the coverage of the PMKISAN scheme in the current financial year.

(b): The 20th instalment under PM-KISAN was released on 02.08.2025. State-wise details of beneficiaries covered under 20th instalment of PM-KISAN is attached at Annexure.

(c): There is no State-wise allocation of funds under PM-KISAN. The funds released to the beneficiaries in the last 3 years, along with the State of Tamil Nadu under PM-KISAN, is as follows:
