#### PM-KISAN YOJANA

#### \*27. SHRI CHANDRA PRAKASH JOSHI:

Will the Minister of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of farmers enrolled under the Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi (PMKISAN) Scheme;
- (b) the total amount disbursed till date;
- (c) the steps taken to ensure cent percent Aadhaar seeding of the beneficiaries; and
- (d) the details of the total number of farmers enrolled under the PM-Kisan Yojana in Rajasthan along with the total amount disbursed till date, district-wise?

#### **ANSWER**

STATEMENT MADE IN REPLY TO PART (a) TO (d) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 27 REGARDING PM-KISAN YOJANA RAISED BY SHRI CHANDRA PRAKASH JOSHI, MP DUE FOR REPLY ON 2<sup>ND</sup> DECEMBER, 2025.

(a) to (d): The PM-KISAN scheme is a central sector scheme launched in February 2019 by the Hon'ble Prime Minister to supplement the financial needs of farmers with cultivable land-holding. Under the scheme, a financial benefit of ₹ 6,000/- per year is transferred in three equal instalments, into the Aadhaar seeded bank accounts of farmers through Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) mode. Under the PM-KISAN Scheme, cultivable landholding is primary eligibility criteria to receive benefit of the Scheme subject to certain exclusions relating to higher economic status.

A farmer-centric digital infrastructure has ensured the benefits of the scheme reach all the farmers across the country without involvement of any intermediaries. Maintaining absolute transparency in registering and verifying beneficiaries, the Government of India has disbursed over Rs. 4.09 lakh Cr. through 21 installments since inception of the Scheme. Of this, ₹ 27,956.15 crore has been disbursed to the beneficiaries of Rajasthan since inception of the scheme. District-wise details of amount released to beneficiaries of Rajasthan is at Annexure -I.

Currently, 100% of the benefits of the PM-KISAN are released via Aadhaar based payment mode to the beneficiaries, whose Aadhaar demo authentication and eKYC are complete, with an exception for farmers belonging to Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups (PVTG).

Recently, the 21st instalment of PM-KISAN was released on 19th November, 2025, under which the benefits of the Scheme were released to more than 9.34 Crore beneficiaries across the country, of which 65.3 lakh beneficiaries belong to the State of Rajasthan. The district-wise details of the beneficiaries benefited in Rajasthan and amount released to them in 21st instalment as on date is attached at Annexure - II.
