Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of skill development centers set up so far in Meerut, Sabarkantha, Mandi Lok Sabha Constituencies and Bhilwara district of Rajasthan to provide employment-oriented training to the youth, centre and year-wise;
- (b) the details of the number of youth trained in the said centres during the last three years, centre and year-wise along with the number of trained youth got employment or self-employment opportunities;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to introduce any specialized training courses in the said Constituencies and Bhilwara in order to meet the demands of local industries;
- (d) if so, the details thereof;
- (e) whether the Government proposes to set up any " Mega Skill Development Centre" in various other districts including Meerut, Sabarkantha and Mandi and Bhilwara; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP

(a) to (f): Under the Government of India's Skill India Mission (SIM) , the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) delivers skill, re-skill and up-skill training through an extensive network of skill development centres under various schemes, viz. Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), Jan Sikhshan Sansthan (JSS), National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS) and Craftsman Training Scheme (CTS) through Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs), to all the sections of the society across the country including the Meerut, Sabarkantha, Mandi Lok Sabha

Constituencies and Bhilwara district of Rajasthan. The SIM aims at enabling youth of India to get future ready and equipped with industry relevant skills. The total number of training centres under these schemes in the Meerut, Sabarkantha, Mandi Lok Sabha Constituencies and Bhilwara district of Rajasthan is given below:

The total number of candidates trained under various schemes of MSDE in Meerut, Sabarkantha, Mandi Lok Sabha Constituencies and Bhilwara district of Rajasthan during last three years are given at **Annexure-I**.

Further, the schemes of MSDE for skill development are demand driven and training centres are set up on need basis. The Government continuously reviews skill requirements emerging from local industries, and specialised training courses are introduced under various schemes as per demand. District Skill Committees (DSCs), established across all States/UTs are mandated with formulating District Skill Development Plans (DSDPs) to promote decentralized planning for skill development and implementation at the grassroots level. The DSDPs identify sectors with employment opportunities as well as the associated demand for skilling in the district, and map the available facilities for Skill Training. Skill Development Programmes of the Government are designed and implemented to bridge identified skill gaps across sectors. 36 Sector Skill Councils (SSCs), led by industry leaders are mandated to identify the skill development needs of respective sectors as well as to determine skill competency standards. SSCs conduct skill gap studies from time to time which provide information on the skills needed. Such studies guide the interventions of the Government for preparing the workforce as per the industry needs.

There is no such proposal for setting up of Mega Skill Development Centre in various other districts including Meerut, Sabarkantha and Mandi and Bhilwara.
