- (a) & (b) There is no centrally sponsored scheme for defence manufacturing in Ministry of Defence.
- (c) & (e) Sixteen Defence Public Sector Undertakings (DPSUs), including seven newly incorporated entities formed on 01 October 2021 from the corporatisation of the erstwhile Ordnance Factory Board and its 41 ordnance factories, are spread across various regions of the country. These Defence Public Sector Undertakings are having presence in different States/ Union Territories and collectively enabling self-reliance in defence sector.
