STATUS OF STARTUPS

- (a) the number of startups recognised and the quantum of funding availed through Funds for Startups till 31st October, 2025, State-wise, particularly Telangana;
- (b) whether Government proposes to establish a dedicated Startup/SEBI facilitation centre in Hyderabad, similar to GIFT city; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

- (a):** As per eligibility conditions prescribed under G.S.R. notification 127 (E) dated 19th February 2019, entities are recognized as 'startups' under the Startup India initiative by the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT). As on 31st October 2025, 1,97,692 entities have been recognized as startups by DPIIT. The State/Union Territory (UT)-wise details of entities recognized as startups by DPIIT as on 31st October 2025, including in the State of Telangana is placed as **Annexure-I**.

Under Startup India initiative, the Government is implementing three flagship Schemes, Fund of Funds for Startups (FFS), Startup India Seed Fund Scheme (SISFS), and Credit Guarantee Scheme for Startups (CGSS) to provide funding opportunities and support startups across sectors at various stages of their business cycle.

FFS has been established to catalyze venture capital investments and is operationalized by Small Industries Development Bank of India (SIDBI), which provides capital to Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI)-registered Alternative Investment Funds (AIFs) which in turn invest in startups. The State/UT- wise amount invested in startups by AIFs selected under FFS as on 31st October 2025, including in the State of Telangana is placed as Annexure-II.

SISFS provides financial assistance to seed stage startups through incubators. SISFS is implemented from 1st April 2021. The State/UT-wise amount approved to startups by incubators selected under SISFS as on 31st October 2025, including in the State of Telangana is placed as **Annexure-III**.

CGSS is implemented for enabling collateral free loans to startups through eligible financial institutions. CGSS is operationalized by the National Credit Guarantee Trustee Company (NCGTC) Limited and has been operationalized from 1st April 2023. The State/UT-wise amount of loans guaranteed to startup borrowers as on 31st October 2025, including in the State of Telangana is placed as **Annexure-IV**.

(b) & (c): As per the Department of Economic Affairs (DEA), currently there is no such proposal under consideration to establish a dedicated Startup/SEBI facilitation centre in Hyderabad, similar to GIFT City.
