PROJECTS IN TAMIL NADU UNDER AMRUT

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware that Tamil Nadu has undertaken 445 projects under the Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) with an approved cost of Rupees 13,339.43 crore and is making steady progress in its implementation;
- (b) if so, the details of these projects including sector-wise distribution such as water supply, sewerage, septage management, stormwater drainage, green spaces and urban transport;
- (c) the extent of Central Assistance released so far for projects under AMRUT in Tamil Nadu;
- (d) the number of projects completed, under implementation and those at various stages of tendering or approval;
- (e) the steps being taken by the Government to further support and strengthen urban infrastructure development in Tamil Nadu under AMRUT 2.0; and
- (f) whether the Government proposes any additional measures to expedite the implementation of ongoing projects and ensure improved service delivery to urban residents in Tamil Nadu and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI TOKHAN SAHU)

(a) to (d): As reported by the State of Tamil Nadu on Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) portal, 445 projects worth ₹13,339.43 crore have been taken up by the State under AMRUT in 28 cities/ towns, of which works worth ₹12864.69 crore have been physically completed.

In water supply sector, State has taken up 18 projects worth ₹7,436.02 crore of which physical works worth ₹7,330.96 crore have been completed; in sewerage/ septage management sector, 18 projects worth ₹5,670.80 crore have been taken up of which physical works worth ₹5,301.12 crore have been completed; in parks & green spaces sector, all 409 projects worth ₹232.61 crore have been completed.

Against the committed central assistance of ₹4,756.58 crore for projects, ₹4,626.24 crore has been released under AMRUT.

- (e) AMRUT 2.0 has been launched on 01 October, 2021 in all Urban Local Bodies (ULBs)/ cities including in the State of Tamil Nadu. Under AMRUT 2.0, States/UTs are empowered to select, appraise, prioritise and implement the projects within the broad framework of Mission guidelines. So far under AMRUT 2.0 in the State of Tamil Nadu, a total of 1,270 projects worth ₹14,687.83 crore (including Operations & Maintenance cost) have been approved by MoHUA, which includes 201 water supply projects worth ₹7,721.59 crore, 30 sewerage and septage management projects worth ₹6,623.40 crore, 474 water body rejuvenation projects worth ₹ 229.19 crore and 565 Green Space & park projects worth ₹ 113.65 crore.
- (f) The Mission guidelines provide for formation of State High Powered Steering Committee (SHPSC) headed by the Chief Secretary of the State, to monitor and supervise implementation of the scheme at the State/ UT level. State Level Technical Committee (SLTC) headed by the Secretary, **Urban Development & Housing Department provides technical support to** the SHPSC in monitoring and supervising the scheme at the State level. Further, an Apex Committee constituted under the ambit of Mission guidelines reviews and monitor the Mission periodically. For assessment and monitoring of work done under AMRUT 2.0 in the States/ UTs, there is a provision of Independent Review and Monitoring Agencies (IRMAs). Also, in order to fast-track the implementation of projects, progress is periodically reviewed and monitored through regular video conferences/ webinars/ workshops/ site-visits etc. by Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) with the States/ UTs. There is a dedicated AMRUT 2.0 online portal for tracking the progress and monitoring of projects.
