CONSTRUCTION OF NHs IN BUNDELKHAND

2005. SHRI ANURAG SHARMA:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) the total length of National Highways presently under construction in the Bundelkhand region of Uttar Pradesh and the length completed during the last three years;**
- (b) the details of new National Highway stretches or additional lane expansion proposed for the districts of Jhansi, Lalitpur, Banda and Chitrakoot;**
- (c) the total funds allocated by the National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) for all ongoing and sanctioned highway projects in Uttar Pradesh, particularly in Bundelkhand and the expenditure incurred so far, scheme-wise and district-wise; and**
- (d) the number of bridges, flyovers and underpasses presently under construction on National Highways in the Bundelkhand region, the number completed and the total expenditure incurred on these structures?**

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

(a) to (d) 8 number of projects are presently ongoing on National Highways (NHs) in the Bundelkhand region of Uttar Pradesh, which comprises of a four laning project in about 46 km length of which about 7.6 km have been completed during the current financial year.

6 number of NH development projects in about 75 km length have been identified for taking up in the districts of Jhansi, Lalitpur, Banda and Chitrakoot.

Funds are allocated for development and maintenance of NHs State/UT-wise/ agency wise and not district / region-wise.

The details of funds allocated and expenditure incurred towards development and maintenance of NHs in the State of Uttar Pradesh during each of the last three years and the current year are as follows:

The flyovers, underpasses and bridges are generally constructed as part of an NH development project involving improvement and upgradation. Funds utilized for construction of bridges, flyovers and underpasses are not maintained separately.

At present, works are ongoing in six number of Road Over Bridges (ROBs)/flyovers, one bridge and two Vehicular Underpasses (VUPs) on NHs in the Bundelkhand region of Uttar Pradesh. One work of reconstruction of minor bridge of NH-35 has been completed in March 2024.
