Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the manner in which the National Career Service (NCS) Portal helped in increasing job matching for job seekers in the country, State/UT-wise, particularly in Pali Lok Sabha Constituency in Rajasthan;**
- (b) the details of the number of job aspirants who have received career counselling and guidance through the NCS portal so far, year and skill-wise, particularly in Pali Lok Sabha Constituency in Rajasthan;**
- (c) the details of the number of Memorandums of Understanding (MoUs) signed between the Private and Government partners to improve the service offering of the NCS along with the major partners; and**
- (d) the details of the steps taken by the Government to integrate gig workers and platform-based employment through the NCS portal in the country, particularly in Rajasthan?**

(a) to (d) The Ministry of Labour and Employment, Government of India, is running the National Career Service (NCS) Portal which brings all the jobseekers and employers on a single platform for job matching in a dynamic, efficient and responsive manner through a digital platform [www.ncs.gov.in].

As on 20.11.2025, NCS Portal has mobilized more than 8.17 crore vacancies which has resulted in shortlisting of more than 2.1 crore Jobseekers in the country. State/UT-wise details of vacancies mobilized may be seen at https://www.ncs.gov.in/_layouts/15/ncsp/ViewStaticReport.aspx

Further, Ministry has signed several MoUs with the private and public employers/ portals/Platforms to strengthen public-private partnerships for enhancing employment opportunities for all jobseekers. Till date more than 25 Memorandums of Understanding (MoUs) have been signed including MoUs with private partners such as Swiggy, Zomato, Amazon, and Zepto which provide gig and platform-based employment opportunities to job seekers through the NCS portal across the country including in Rajasthan.

NCS Portal provides online/offline career counselling and vocational guidance services to its registered users. More than 1182 Career Counsellors have been on boarded on NCS portal. Till date more than 55 Lakh online/ offline career guidance sessions have been conducted nationwide, of which more than 2.3 Lakh sessions have been held in Rajasthan, including Pali Lok Sabha Constituency.

The National Career Service (NCS) portal has been integrated with the e-Shram portal, which is a database of over 30 crore unorganized workers, including gig and platform workers. This integration enables all e-Shram registrants, including those from the State of Rajasthan, to access the full range of services available on the NCS portal, such as job search and related facilities.
