SC/ST BENEFICIARIES IN ANDHRA PRADESH

245. SHRI MADDILA GURUMOORTHY:

Will the Minister of FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING

be pleased to state:

- a) the total funds allocated, released under the National Livestock Mission (NLM) to Andhra Pradesh since 2021 to till date especially Tirupati district;
- b) the details of physical and financial achievements under the scheme during such period;
- c) the number of beneficiaries from Scheduled Caste (SC) and Scheduled Tribe (ST) communities who have been supported under the NLM scheme in Andhra Pradesh in Tirupati district;
- d) whether there is any special component under NLM to promote livestock development among SC/ST farmers; and
- e) if not, whether the Government has any proposals to support for equitable livestock sector development?

ANSWER

**THE MINISTER OF FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING
(SHRI RAJIV RANJAN SINGH ALIAS LALAN SINGH)**

- a) The total funds allocated and released is Rs. 113.06 Cr to Andhra Pradesh since 2021-22 to till date under NLM. The total funds allocated to Tirupati district is Rs. 5.33 Cr and released Rs. 5.27 Cr since 2021-22 to till date under NLM.
- (b) In Tirupati District, 18,553 animals were insured with the financial expenditure of Rs.2.29 Cr, 1463 tonnes of fodder seed were distributed with the financial expenditure of Rs.2.98 Cr and 1316 farmers were trained and seminars for 62 vets and para vets were organised under skill development programme with the financial expenditure of Rs.98.00 Lakhs.
- (c) Under Livestock Insurance component, 3612 SC beneficiaries and 729 ST beneficiaries were supported under the NLM scheme in Tirupati District. 2385 SC beneficiaries and 1194 ST beneficiaries were supported with supply of fodder seed and 748 SC beneficiaries and 301 ST beneficiaries were trained under the NLM scheme in Tirupati District.
- (d) & (e) The funds are being released to States under SCSP and TSP head of the budget of total outlay to support SC and ST beneficiaries under NLM.
