IMPLEMENTATION OF MGNREGS IN ANDHRA PRADESH

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the total number of funds allocated, released and disbursed under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS) during the last five years for Andhra Pradesh, year and district-wise;
- (b) the details and the total number of days of employment provided during the last five years in Andhra Pradesh, year and district-wise;
- (c) the work demand under MGNREGS during the last five years in Andhra Pradesh, district and year-wise; and
- (d) the details of the total pending liabilities (wage and material) and number of people impacted during the last five years in Andhra Pradesh, year and district-wise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI KAMLESH PASWAN)

(a): Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (Mahatma Gandhi NREGS) is a demand driven wage employment scheme. There is no State/UT-wise allocation of funds under Mahatma Gandhi NREGS.

Details of funds released to the State of Andhra Pradesh under Mahatma Gandhi NREGS in the last five financial years from FY 2020-21 to 2024-25 are given below:

While wage payments are directly credited by Central Government to the account of beneficiaries through the Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) protocol, for material component, funds are released to the State Government, which in turn releases the funds to Districts through SNA SPARSH module.
