- (a) whether the Government has initiated any work on the next all-India survey on Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) following the 73rd round National Sample Survey (NSS) on unincorporated non-agricultural enterprises; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the timeline for completion and release of the next MSME survey and if not, the reasons for the delay?

(a) and (b): The National Sample Survey (NSS) under the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (MoSPI) has conducted Annual Survey of Unincorporated Sector Enterprises (ASUSE 2023-24) during October, 2023 - September, 2024 to cover the unincorporated non-agricultural sectors belonging to manufacturing, trade and other services sectors.

As per requirement of the Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME), the estimated number of establishments classified as Micro, Small and Medium at State/UT level and also for the activity category level has been generated and published in the ASUSE 2023-24 report, which is available in public domain at website of MoSPI.
