HOUSING AND URBAN INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS IN HARYANA

NO. 3048. SHRI DEEPENDER SINGH HOODA:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has sanctioned any housing or urban infrastructure projects in Haryana during the last ten years including the current year and if so, the details of each project, stating name, location, implementing agency, sanctioned cost, Central and State/ULB share, date of sanction, present status, budget allocated and released for each financial year including the current financial year along with the expected completion timeline;**
- (b) the number of houses sanctioned under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana-Urban (PMAY-U) for Haryana since 2015-16 along with Central assistance released and houses grounded and completed;**
- (c) the details of other major projects such as Rapid Metro expansions, Regional Rapid Transit System (RRTS) and affordable housing missions under PMAY-U 2.0 including project costs, present status and completion timelines; and**
- (d) whether periodic reviews or monitoring mechanisms are in place to track progress and ensure timely completion of these projects, if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?**

**ANSWER

- (a) to (c): As per the provisions of Article 243 W of the Constitution, in conjunction with the Seventh and Twelfth Schedules, matters relating to urban development fall within the purview of States/ Urban Local Bodies (ULBs). However, Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) provides programmatic support to the States/ Union Territories (UTs) in their urban development agenda through its various flagship Missions/ Programmes viz. Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) 2.0, Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana – Urban (PMAY-U) 2.0, Swachh Bharat Mission – Urban (SBM-U) 2.0, Urban Transport (UT), etc.**

Through these Missions/Schemes, the Central Government approves the State Plans and provides the Central Assistance (CA) to the States. The projects are selected, designed, approved and executed by the States/UTs and the cities. The State Governments release funds to the cities/districts.

AMRUT: This mission launched in the year 2015 in selected 500 cities (now 485 cities including 15 merged cities) and towns across the country was focused on development of basic infrastructure in urban areas, in the sectors of water supply, sewerage and septage management, etc. AMRUT 2.0 was launched in the year 2021 in all ULBs/ cities, enabling the cities to become 'self-reliant' and 'water secure'. Providing universal coverage of sewerage and septage management in 500 AMRUT cities is one of the major focus areas of AMRUT 2.0. Under the Mission, States/ UTs are empowered to select appraise, propose and implement projects. Under AMRUT, Haryana State has taken up 136 projects worth ₹2,919.99 crore. Under AMRUT 2.0 so far, 77 projects worth ₹3,823.54 crore as submitted by the State have been approved. City/ULBs wise major projects in Haryana taken up/approved under AMRUT and AMRUT 2.0 is attached at Annexure-I.

The Mission guidelines provide for formation of State High Powered Steering Committee (SHPSC) headed by the Chief Secretary of the State, to monitor and supervise implementation of the scheme at the State/ UT level. State Level Technical Committee (SLTC) headed by the Secretary, Urban Development & Housing Department provides technical support to the SHPSC in monitoring and supervising the scheme at the State level. Further, an Apex Committee constituted under the ambit of Mission guidelines reviews and monitor the Mission periodically. Also, in order to fast-track the implementation of projects, progress is periodically reviewed and monitored through regular video conferences/ webinars/ workshops/ site-visits etc. by MoHUA with the States/ UTs.

SBM-U: This Mission supplements the efforts of States/UTs by providing policy directions, financial and technical support. Under SBM-U 2.0, Central Share of funds are released to the States/UTs on the basis of receipt of action plans from States/UTs duly approved by SLTC which are further transmitted to ULBs by the concerned State/UT as per State action plan. Funds under SBM-U are allocated for the entire mission period and not on yearly basis. Against Mission allocation of Rs.539.80 Cr, a total of Rs.573.04 Cr having central share of Rs.207.71 Cr has been approved for State of Haryana under the components of Toilet construction, Used Water Management (UWM) and Solid Waste Management (SWM).

PMAY-U: MoHUA has been implementing PMAY-U since 25.06.2015 with an aim to provide all weather pucca houses with basic civic amenities to eligible urban beneficiaries across the country. The scheme period has been extended up to 31.12.2025 to complete sanctioned houses without changing the funding pattern and implementation methodology. Based on the learnings from the experiences of implementation of PMAY-U, MoHUA has revamped the scheme and launched PMAY-U 2.0 'Housing for All' Mission with effect from 01.09.2024 for implementation in urban areas across the country to support one crore additional eligible beneficiaries in next five years. PMAY-U 2.0 is implemented through four verticals i.e., Beneficiary Led Construction (BLC), Affordable Housing in Partnership (AHP), Affordable Rental Housing (ARH) and Interest Subsidy Scheme (ISS). The scheme guidelines can be accessed at <https://pmay-urban.gov.in/uploads/guidelines/Operational-Guidelines-of-PMAY-U-2.pdf>. PMAY-U & PMAY-U 2.0 are demand driven scheme. Selection of beneficiaries, under various verticals preferred by the beneficiaries, formulation of projects and execution including allotment of completed houses to the eligible beneficiaries are done by States/ UTs. City/Location wise details of physical and financial progress along with CA released during each of the last 10 years and current year in projects under PMAY-U & PMAY-U 2.0 in the State of Haryana are attached at Annexure-II.

Urban Transport: During the last ten Financial Years including the current Year, the following projects have been sanctioned by Gol in the State of Haryana:

(d) In order to expedite the implementation of the projects under various flagship Missions/Programmes of the Ministry, various institutional frameworks like provisions of progress reports, review by undertaking field visits have been put in place. Moreover, periodic review meetings in States/UTs and through video conferences are also held for the purpose. Further, there is a dedicated AMRUT 2.0 online portal for tracking the progress and monitoring of projects. Besides, the State Governments also monitor the progress of the Missions with a view to expedite their implementation.
