Will the Minister of TRIBAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) the total number of villages identified for development and interventions sanctioned in the country, State-wise including Dumka, Jharkhand, Kanker under Kanker Lok Sabha Constituency Kondagaon, Balod and Dhamtari districts of Chhattisgarh, Mandi in Uttar Pradesh, Mandi Lok Sabha Constituency in Himachal Pradesh, Bhilwara Lok Sabha Constituency in Rajasthan and West/East Champaran in Bihar and Jalgaon Lok Sabha Constituency of Maharashtra under the Pradhan Mantri Janjatiya Unnat Gram Abhiyan (PMJUGA) along with the criteria adopted for their selection and the time limit set for the completion of the first phase of the same;

(b) the details and the amount of funds allocated and released so far to each State particularly for the State of Chhattisgarh including Ministry of Tribal Affairs component and convergence schemes like PMAY-G under the said mission along with details of the financial convergence from the Development Action Plan for Scheduled Tribes (DAPST);

(c) whether the Government is taking any measures to ensure long-term sustainability, community participation and institutional accountability of the assets created under the said PMJUGA mission and if so, the details thereof;

(d) the details of projects proposed or implemented and key achievements with regard to houses sanctioned/completed, roads, water connections provided as of November 2025;

(e) the details of any special measures planned for Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups (PVTGs) and Left-Wing Extremism (LWE)-affected districts in Chhattisgarh; and

(f) whether any villages from the Jalgaon Lok Sabha region of Maharashtra have been identified under this programme for integrated tribal development and tourism-linked livelihood enhancement, if so, the details thereof about the projects proposed or implemented with the involvement of local tribal communities in the said identified villages?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR TRIBAL AFFAIRS

(a) The Pradhan Mantri Janjatiya Unnat Gram Abhiyan (PMJUGA), launched as Dharti Aaba Janjatiya Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan (DAJGUA) on 2nd October 2024, targets 63,843 tribal-majority villages spread over 549 districts and 2,911 blocks in 30 States/UTs, benefiting over 5 crore tribal persons in five years (FY 2024-25 to FY 2028-29). A State/UT-wise list of identified villages including Dumka, Jharkhand, Kanker under Kanker Lok Sabha Constituency Kondagaon, Balod and Dhamtari districts of Chhattisgarh, Mandi in Uttar Pradesh, Mandi Lok Sabha Constituency in Himachal Pradesh, Bhilwara Lok Sabha Constituency in Rajasthan and West/East Champaran in Bihar and Jalgaon Lok Sabha Constituency of Maharashtra is as per Annexure.

Villages were selected based on Antyodaya gap analysis and prescribed norms. In plains areas, villages with a population of 500 or more and having at least 50% Scheduled Tribe (ST) population were considered. For North-Eastern and Hill States, villages with a population of 250 or more were included. In Left-Wing Extremism (LWE) affected districts, villages with a population of 100 or more were selected. Along with this, villages located in Aspirational Blocks having 50 or more tribal persons were also covered under the scheme.

Time Limit (Phase & Overall): The Dharti Aaba Janjatiya Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan (DAJGUA) is a five-year mission spanning FY 2024–25 to FY 2028–29.

(b) The funds released particularly for the State of Chhattisgarh in respect of tribal development are as under:

- PMAY-G (Housing): In Chhattisgarh, 8.47 lakh houses have been sanctioned historically, with an additional 3.03 lakh houses approved in Jan 2025, aligned with the mission's saturation goals. Unit assistance remains 1.20 lakh (plain) and 1.30 lakh (LWE/hilly) with 60:40 Centre: State funding in non-Himalayan States.

(c) The Government has taken comprehensive measures to ensure long term sustainability, community participation and institutional accountability of the assets created under Pradhan Mantri Janjatiya Unnat Gram Abhiyan (PMJUGA) or Dharti Aaba Janjatiya Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan (DAJGUA). These are:-

- i. Creation of assets: pucca houses, all-weather roads, piped water, reliable electricity, schools etc.
- ii. Livelihood support for FRA patta holders through sustainable agriculture and allied activities.
- iii. Gram Sabha-led planning and implementation of Community Forest Resource Management Plans.
- iv. Monitoring at State, District, Block level committees.
- v. Real-time monitoring of expenditure through PFMS SNA Sparsh module.

(d) the details of projects proposed or implemented and key achievements with regard to houses sanctioned/completed, roads, water connections etc. provided by Line Ministries/Departments as on 11th November 2025, are as under:

(e) Under the scheme of Pradhan Mantri Janjatiya Unnat Gram Abhiyan (PMJUGA) or Dharti Aaba Janjatiya Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan (DAJGUA), there is no specific provision of Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups (PVTG) and Left Wing Extremism (LWE). However, under the On 15th November 2023, Hon'ble Prime Minister launched Pradhan Mantri Janjati Adivasi Nyaya Maha AbhiyaN (PM JANMAN) for socio-economic development of 75 PVTG communities residing in 18 states and one UT including Chhattisgarh. The mission aims to provide basic facilities to improve their socio-economic conditions such as safe housing, clean drinking water and improved access to education, health and nutrition, road and telecom connectivity, electrification of unelectrified households and sustainable livelihood opportunities. These objectives are being met through 11 interventions implemented by 9-line Ministries".

(f) Pradhan Mantri Janjatiya Unnat Gram Abhiyan (PMJUGA) or Dharti Aaba Janjatiya Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan (DAJGUA) covers 112 tribal-majority villages in Jalgaon. As on date, this Ministry has not received proposals for Jalgaon District.
