- (a) the number of food-processing units approved under the Creation/ Expansion of Food Processing and Preservation Capacities (CEFPPC) scheme in Western Uttar Pradesh region including Muzaffarnagar during the last five years and their current and updated status of these units and if not, the reasons therefor; and

(a): During the last five years, a total of three food processing units have been approved under the Creation/ Expansion of Food Processing and Preservation Capacities (CEFPPC) scheme in Western Uttar Pradesh region including Muzaffarnagar.
