931. SHRI SHASHANK MANI:

Will the Minister of PORTS, SHIPPING AND WATERWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has conducted fresh assessments for identifying new Coastal Economic Zones linked with PM Gati Shakti;
- (b) the status of multimodal connectivity planning for recently approved ports and waterways;and
- (c) whether the Government proposes to introduce digital port logistics systems across all major ports in the next three years?

- (a) No Sir.
- (b) Government has approved construction of 32.14 km approach road and 22.22 km rail line for road and rail connectivity respectively for recently approved Vadhavan Port in Maharashtra. The newly constructed waterways terminals at Varanasi, Sahibganj and Haldia on National Waterways - 1 have road connectivity and DPR study is being taken up for rail connectivity for these terminals.
- (c) Yes, Government has launched National Logistic Portal Marine (Sagar Setu) with a vision to provide one stop platform aimed at connecting all stakeholders of the logistic community including major ports using information technology.
