CANCER TREATMENT FACILITIES AT AIIMS

Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:-

- (a) the details of All India Institutes of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) that have functional cancer treatment facilities and are currently operational;
- (b) the total number of Government hospitals that have cancer care facilities in the country, State-wise; and
- (c) the total number of registered oncologists, radiologists, pathologists and nurses in all cancer care hospitals across the country, as of 31st October, 2025?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI PRATAPRAO JADHAV)

- (a): Cancer treatment facilities are functional in All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) Delhi and 18 AIIMS set up under Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY).
- (b) & (c): Public Health is a State subject. However, to enhance the facilities for tertiary care of cancer, under the National Programme for Prevention and Control of Non-Communicable Diseases, financial assistance is provided to States and Union Territories for setting up of State Cancer Institutes (SCIs) and Tertiary Care Cancer Centres (TCCCs). Till date, 39 Institutions (19 SCI and 20 TCCC) have been approved under the scheme.
