**UTILIZATION OF FUNDS UNDER THE SMART CITIES MISSION**

**NO. 189. SHRI E T MOHAMMED BASHEER:**

**Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Government has assessed the total quantum of unutilised Central and State funds under the Smart Cities Mission and if so, the details thereof; and**
- (b) the steps taken or proposed to be taken by the Government to ensure long-term maintenance, sustainable operational funding and integration of Integrated Command and Control Centres into the municipal governance framework of all the hundred Smart Cities?**

**(a) & (b): A statement is laid on the Table of the House.**

**STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY OF PARTS (a) & (b) OF THE LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 189 FOR ANSWER ON 12.02.2026 REGARDING UTILIZATION OF FUNDS UNDER THE SMART CITIES MISSION**

- (a) Under Smart Cities Mission (SCM), out of Central Government's allocation of ₹48,000 Cr, the cities have been able to claim central financial assistance of ₹47,458 Cr (i.e. 99% of the total Central share allocation for cities) of which of ₹46,231 Cr has been utilized (i.e. 97% of the total Central share allocation for cities).**

**Post closure of SCM on 31.03.2025, Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) has issued Advisory No. 27 dated 10<sup>th</sup> June 2025. As per the advisory, the SPV are to ensure submission of their Utilization Certificates (UCs) for the GOI funds released to them not later than March 2026.**

**City wise details of the Central Financial Assistance claimed and utilized, State fund claimed and utilized are at Annexure.**

- (b) The Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) has issued advisories and conducted periodic review meetings to ensure the long-term maintenance and sustainable operational funding of Integrated Command and Control Centres (ICCCs). As per Advisory No. 27 dated 10<sup>th</sup> June 2025, all SPVs are to ensure the timely completion of all ongoing SCM projects and prepare O&M plans for the assets created. The Advisory has further outlined the envisioned future role of SPVs of smart cities and a roadmap for the continued functioning of ICCCs. The advisory underscores repurposing of SPVs to meet emerging urban challenges. Further, as per the advisory, ICCCs are to be leveraged as city operating systems and state analytical hubs, with operational control preferably retained by the urban development departments. SPVs may receive service-linked revenues for managing ICCC functions. States and Union Territories, through their respective High-Powered Steering Committees (HPSCs), have been encouraged to chart out urban sector priorities and map areas where SPVs can continue to play a strategic role.**

**Additionally, Advisory No. 29 on Outcomes of the National Conference on 'Making Cities Cybersecure' encourages ICCCs towards cyber resilience and financial sustainability. This includes developing models to ensure the financial sustainability of ICCCs, monetizing existing assets, exploring the possibility of sharing revenue and innovative financing models.**

**MoHUA has encouraged ICCCs towards integration of line departments within the municipal governance and has also recommended ICCCs to render services to the line departments of Urban Local Bodies (ULBs). The ICCCs support municipal governance through integration with ULB systems for solid waste management, water supply and sanitation, disaster management, health, energy, environmental, e-governance and grievance redressal to ensure efficient monitoring and delivery of municipal services to citizens.**
