FLYOVER AT 8 BS LEVEL CROSSING GATE, RAMNAGAR, SILCHAR

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government has assessed the severe traffic congestion at the 8 BS level crossing gate at Ramnagar near Silchar Railway Station in Cachar district, Assam and if so, the details thereof;

(b) whether construction of a flyover at this special-class crossing has been proposed in coordination with the State Government and Railways and if so, the details thereof; and

(c) the present status and timeline for completion of the proposed project?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (c) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 384 ANSWERED ON 19TH MARCH, 2026 ASKED BY SHRI PARIMAL SUKLABAIIDYA REGARDING 'FLYOVER AT 8 BS LEVEL CROSSING GATE, RAMNAGAR, SILCHAR'.

(a) to (c) Level Crossing No. 8 BS falls on the existing NH-37 city portion in Silchar town between Rongpur and Inter-State Bus Terminus (ISBT), for which preparation of Detailed Project Report (DPR) has been taken up for construction of Road Over Bridge (ROB). For decongestion of Silchar town, bypass is under construction in two packages i.e. (i) Rongpur–Sonabarighat section (7.2 km), 4-laning of which is under implementation and (ii) Sonabarighat–ISBT section (11.5 km), which has already been upgraded to 2-lane with paved shoulder standards.

Upon completion of the bypass of Silchar, all the heavy commercial traffic is expected to ply through the said bypass, thereby reducing the congestion on the existing city portion of NH passing through Silchar town.
