- (a) the details of the funds allocated by the Government under the Urban Basic Services (UBS) Programme to improve the living standards of the poor people residing in cities during each of the last three years as on date, State-wise;**
- (b) the names of the districts across the country that have been included/covered under the said programme; and**
- (c) the basic problems of the poor being addressed through the said programme?**

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN THE LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 3 DUE FOR ANSWER ON 29.01.2026 REGARDING “FUNDS ALLOCATED UNDER URBAN BASIC SERVICES PROGRAMME”

(a) to (c): Government of India launched Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JnNURM) in December 2005 for assisting States/Union Territories (UTs) by extending Central Assistance for providing houses and related civic amenities to urban poor including slum dwellers in 65 selected cities under Basic Services to the Urban Poor (BSUP).

The period of JnNURM was upto March 2012. However, to complete the on-going projects sanctioned upto 31.03.2012, the period was extended and funds were released upto March 2017.

The State/UT-wise and city-wise details of physical and financial progress under BSUP component of JnNURM in the country is at Annexure.

Since scheme has ended long back, no funds were allocated/released during the last three years and the current year.

Further, Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) has been implementing Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana - Urban (PMAY-U) since 25.06.2015 with an aim to provide all weather pucca houses with basic civic amenities to all eligible urban beneficiaries across the country. Based on the learnings from the experiences of implementation of PMAY-U, MoHUA has revamped the scheme and launched PMAY-U 2.0 ‘Housing for All’ Mission with effect from 01.09.2024 for implementation in urban areas across the country to construct, purchase and rent a house by 1 crore additional eligible beneficiaries at affordable cost in next five years. PMAY-U 2.0 is implemented through four verticals i.e., Beneficiary Led Construction (BLC), Affordable Housing in Partnership (AHP), Affordable Rental Housing (ARH) and Interest Subsidy Scheme (ISS).

Based on the project proposal submitted by States/Union Territories (UTs), a total of 122.28 lakh houses, including 10.66 lakh under PMAY-U 2.0, have been sanctioned under the schemes by the Ministry, so far across the country including Uttar Pradesh. Out of which, 114.84 lakh houses have been grounded and 97.02 lakh are completed/delivered to the beneficiaries.
