**Ayushman Arogya Mandirs**

\*416 Shri Vishnu Datt Sharma:

Will the Minister of AYUSH be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is establishing Ayushman Arogya Mandirs (AYUSH) under the National AYUSH Mission (NAM) to strengthen primary healthcare delivery through AYUSH systems in the country and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether any such AYUSH Health and Wellness Centres have been established or proposed in the State of Madhya Pradesh, particularly in Katni, Panna and Khajuraho in the Khajuraho Lok Sabha constituency, if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the timeframe for extending such facilities to the said region?

**The Statement referred in reply to Lok Sabha Starred Question No. 416 for 20.03.2026**

(a) Under Centrally Sponsored Scheme of National Ayush Mission (NAM), as per the proposals received from State/UT Governments through their State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs), 12500 units of Ayushman Arogya Mandir (Ayush) [AAM (Ayush)] have been approved by upgrading existing Ayush Dispensaries and Sub Health Centres to strengthen primary healthcare delivery through Ayush systems across the country. As reported by State/UT Governments, all AAM (Ayush) are functional. State/UT-wise status of approved AAM (Ayush) is furnished at **Annexure-I**.

(b) & (c) Public Health being a State subject, establishment of Ayush Health & Wellness Centres [now renamed as Ayushman Arogya Mandir (AAM) (Ayush)] in any district of Madhya Pradesh, comes under the purview of State Government of Madhya Pradesh. However, under NAM, as per the proposals received from State Government of Madhya Pradesh through the SAAPs, 800 AAM (Ayush) have been approved and as reported by State Government, all AAM(Ayush) are functional. The district wise details of approved AAM (Ayush) in the State of Madhya Pradesh including Katni, Panna and Khajuraho in the Khajuraho Lok Sabha constituency are furnished at **Annexure-II**.
