**CARGO OWNERS**

1196. SHRI B K PARTHASARATHI:

Will the Minister of PORTS, SHIPPING AND WATERWAYS be pleased to state:

**पत्तन, पोत परिवहन और जलमार्ग मंत्री**

- (a) whether the Government maintains the data regarding the number of cargo owners operating in India, if so, the details thereof, State-wise;
- (b) the number of cargo owners registered and approved for receiving incentives under the JalVahak Scheme indicating the incentive disbursed to beneficiaries till date;
- (c) the number of scheduled services being offered under the scheme along with the total number of vessels operating for such services;
- (d) whether the Government is monitoring vessel utilization capacity and the average cost incurred per trip for these scheduled services, if so, the details thereof;
- (e) the details of feedback obtained from cargo owners under both components of the scheme;
- (f) the criteria adopted for selecting waterways and routes covered under the JalVahak Scheme; and
- (g) whether the assessment of the performance of the scheme has been completed, if so, the details thereof?

**ANSWER**

(a)& (b) The data for all cargo owners operating in India is not available. The number of cargo owners registered and approved for receiving incentives under the Jalvahak Scheme are 10 and 6 respectively. However, no incentive has been disbursed till date as none of the above mentioned entities has submitted any claim for cargo movement.

- (c) Two schedule services namely Kolkata/Haldia to Varanasi and Kolkata/Haldia to Pandu are operating under the Jalvahak Scheme and five vessels are operating for these scheduled services.
- (d) Details of vessel utilisation capacity and the average cost incurred per trip for these scheduled are at Annexure-I.
- (e) Feedback received from cargo owners, namely, Tata Steel, Ultratech Cement,, Birla White Cement and stone aggregators on scheduled services is encouraging. However, there is no feed back on incentive to cargo owners as no claim for movement has been made
- (f) The JalvahakScheme is applicable to National Waterway (NW-1), National Waterway-2 (NW-2) and National Waterway-16 (NW-16)and the routescovered under the Scheme are (i) Haldia/Kolkata – Patna/Varanasi (ii) Haldia/Kolkata – Guwahati – via IBP Route and (iii) Haldia/Kolkata – Karimganj/Badarpur via IBP Route.
- (g) During last one year, performance of scheduled services on NW-1 and NW-2 has demonstrated a steady growth in cargo volume as well as improved cost efficiency. As per actual performance data, total cargo carried is15883 MT against annual target of 11400 MT and achievement is 139% of the targeted cargo volume.
