Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the data of the number of Ayushman Vay Vandana Cards (AVVC) issued across the country since its launch in October 2024 till date, State/UT-wise, district-wise in Karnataka particularly Bengaluru district and Palghat district in Kerala, Maharashtra, Jharkhand, Jammu and Kashmir and Madhya Pradesh;
- (b) the data of the utilisation of benefits under AVVC;
- (c) the total value of claims authorised so far in the country and the distribution of AVVC beneficiaries by gender and rural-urban categories of the country, State-wise with specific reference to Karnataka; and

(d) the number of public and private hospitals providing treatment/special facilities under AVVC across the country including tribal dominated areas, State/UT-wise particularly Palghat district in Kerala and district-wise in Karnataka and Madhya Pradesh?

(a): The State/UT-wise and district wise details of number of Ayushman Vay Vandana cards created under Ayushman Bharat - Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY) can be accessed at: <https://dashboard.nha.gov.in/public/card>

(b) and (c): As on 31.12.2025, 10.34 lakh hospital admissions, amounting to Rs. 2,156.04 crore, have been authorized for the Ayushman Vay Vandana card beneficiaries. Out of these, 3.94 lakh admissions, amounting to Rs. 820.75 crore, pertain to female beneficiaries and 6.40 lakh admissions, amounting to Rs. 1335.29 crore, pertain to male beneficiaries across the implementing States/UTs. The State/UT-wise and gender-wise details of hospital admissions for the Ayushman Vay Vandana card beneficiaries are at **Annexure**.

(d): As on 31.12.2025, more than 33,270 hospitals are empanelled under AB-PMJAY that include 17,537 public and 15,733 private hospitals. The Ayushman Vay Vandana card beneficiaries can avail services at any AB-PMJAY empanelled hospitals.
