**(a): The Niveshak Didi initiative aims to enhance financial literacy and awareness among women from Self Help Groups (SHGs), Mahila Mandals and rural households in underserved areas. Under this initiative Investor Awareness Programmes (IAPs) / Camps are conducted at Anganwadis, SHGs and Mahila Mandals. The initiative does not envisage provision of training to women entrepreneurs specifically.**

**(b): Niveshak Didi initiative has no provision to provide financial assistance.**

**(c): In view of the reply to (a) & (b) above, there are no such beneficiaries.**
