Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state

- (a) the total number of enterprises registered on the Udyam Registration and Udyam Assist platforms as of December 2025, State-wise including Maharashtra;
- (b) the steps taken to ensure better outreach and support to tribal and women entrepreneurs to ensure their participation in the Udyam Registration process and to avail benefits of Government schemes particularly in Palghar district of Maharashtra;
- (c) the details of the revised Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) classification criteria announced in Budget 2025-26, including the enhanced investment and turnover limits;
- (d) the expected impact of the revised classification on inclusion of more enterprises within the MSME ambit and their access to benefits;
- (e) the district-wise details of the registered units under MSMEs in Rajasthan including the Bhilwara Lok Sabha Constituency; and
- (f) the digital initiatives undertaken to simplify registration and compliance processes for MSMEs?

**ANSWER**

- (a): The details of enterprises registered on the Udyam Registration Portal (URP) and Udyam Assist Platform (UAP) as of 31<sup>st</sup> December 2025, State-wise, including State of Maharashtra are given at 'Annexure-I'
- (b): A number of steps are being taken to ensure better outreach and support to tribal and women entrepreneurs for facilitating their registration on Udyam Registration Portal and enabling them to avail benefits of Government schemes across all the States of the country, including Maharashtra and the Palghar district. These includes awareness programmes, registration camps, hand holding support through Ministry of MSME's field offices and Common Service Centers(CSCs), coordination with State Governments and Local Bodies. In addition under National SC/ST Hub Scheme of the Ministry of MSME support to the SC/ST owned enterprises is provided.

(c) and (d): The revised criteria of classification of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) was announced in Budget 2025-26, with enhanced investment and turnover limits as mentioned below:

For achieving higher efficiencies of scale, technological upgradation and better access to capital, the investment and turnover limits for classification of MSMEs was enhanced. The enhanced re-classification limits of Investment and Turnover safeguards the benefits intended exclusively for micro enterprises.

(e): The district-wise details of the registered MSMEs in Rajasthan, including the Bhilwara Lok Sabha Constituency are given at 'Annexure-II'.

(f): The revised definition of MSMEs, based on the twin criteria of investment and turnover, was adopted in 2020 and Notification S.O. 2119(E) dated 26.06.2020 was issued. To facilitate the enterprises and promote Ease of doing Business, Udyam Registration Portal was launched for registration of an enterprise on 01.07.2020. Udyam registration process is voluntary, fully online, free, paperless and based on self-declaration. No documents or proof are required to be uploaded for registering on Udyam Registration Portal. Aadhaar Number and PAN is enough for registration. Authentication of Udyam Registration is being done by online verification of Aadhaar through OTP. Any number of activities including manufacturing or service or both may be specified or added in one Registration based on self declaration. The process is fully automated and there is no human intervention involved at the end of the Ministry. Further, initiatives like Champions Portal and Online Dispute Resolution (ODR) Portal have also been taken to support MSMEs and simplify compliance process.
