Pradhan Mantri Jan Vikas Karyakram (PMJVK) is a Centrally Sponsored Scheme of the Ministry of Minority Affairs for creation of community infrastructure in Minority Concentration Areas across the country in sectors such as health, skill development, education, women-centric projects, drinking water supply, sanitation, sports, renewable energy, tourism, animal husbandry and other community infrastructure.

PMJVK is a demand-driven scheme, under which funds are released to States/Union Territories based on eligible project proposals received from them, in accordance with the scheme guidelines. Accordingly, no State-wise, district-wise or block-wise allocation is made at the Budget stage under the scheme.

Therefore, no specific quantum of funds has been earmarked in Budget 2026 for infrastructure development in the minority-dominated blocks of Saharanpur district, Uttar Pradesh under PMJVK.
