- (c) the details of the demolition of the existing Government buildings across Rajpath/Kartavya Path;
- (d) the expected schedule for the completion of the Central Vista Projects;
- (e) whether the Government can accommodate all the Central Government Offices in the proposed Common Central Secretariat and if so, the details thereof;
- (f) the total amount of funds earmarked for the construction of the Central Vista Projects;
- (g) the current status of projects completed out of the total number of sanctioned projects; and
- (h) the total estimated cost of the project at the beginning and project-wise price escalation?

Construction of CCS-8&9	Construction in progress
Construction of CCS-10	Construction in progress
Comprehensive Conservation, retrofitting of North block Building (Yuge Yugeen Bharat Museum)	Construction in progress
Comprehensive Conservation, retrofitting of South block Building	Tender invited
Construction of CCS-4&5	Tender invited

(c): IGNCA, Raksha Bhawan, Old Vice President Residence and Vigyan Bhawan Annex have been demolished.

Construction of CCS-4&5	April, 2028
Comprehensive Conservation, retrofitting Of North block Building (Yuge Yugeen Bharat Museum)	August, 2027
Comprehensive Conservation, retrofitting Of South block Building	March, 2028

(e): The proposed Common Central Secretariat buildings are designed to accommodate all the Ministries & Departments of Government of India in Delhi.
