Will the Minister of TRIBAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the target and timeline set for the implementation of Dharti Aaba Janjatiya Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan (DA-JGUA) launched on 02 October, 2024 in Maharashtra;
- (b) the details of district/block/village-wise works sanctioned in Maharashtra under the said scheme;
- (c) whether all tribal-dominated villages and aspirational blocks of Maharashtra have been included in the said scheme; and
- (d) if so, the number of villages covered under the said scheme and the details of the villages yet to be covered?

(a) Hon'ble Prime Minister launched Dharti Aaba Janjatiya Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan (DAJGUA) on 2nd October 2024. The Abhiyan comprises of 25 interventions implemented by 17-line Ministries and aims to saturate infrastructural gaps in 63,843 villages, improve access to health, education, Anganwadi facilities and providing livelihood opportunities in 549 districts and 2,911 blocks in 30 States/UTs during the period 2024-25 to 2028-29.

The target and timeline set for the implementation of Dharti Aaba Janjatiya Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan (DA-JGUA) is as under:
