SMID COMPONENT OF DAY-NULM

NO. 2242. SHRI KARAN BHUSHAN SINGH

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government maintains the data on the number of Self-Help Groups (SHGs), Area Level Federations (ALFs) and City Level Federations (CLFs) formed under the Social Mobilization and Institution Development (SMID) component of the Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana-National Urban Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NULM), if so, the details thereof, State/UT and Urban Local Body/District/city-wise;**
- (b) whether such disaggregated data includes information on the functional status of these institutions such as frequency of meetings, savings regularity, bookkeeping and access to bank credit, if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons for not capturing these key performance indicators at the national level; and**
- (c) whether the Government proposes to standardise and mandate uniform reporting formats across States and Urban Local Bodies for capturing granular, verifiable and outcome-oriented data on SHGs and federations under SMID and if so, the details thereof along with the timeline and institutional mechanism envisaged for the same?**

- (a): The Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) maintains data on the number of Self-Help Groups (SHGs), Area Level Federations (ALFs) and City Level Federations (CLFs) formed under the SMID component only at State/UT level. The information under the SMID Component, as received from States/UTs from the year 2014 to 2024 (as on September 30, 2024) is annexed at Annexure-I.**

(b): The centrally maintained data primarily relates the physical and financial progress, such as the number of SHGs/federations formed, fund released and credit linkages facilitated. Disaggregated data on functional performance indicators such as frequency of meeting, regularity of savings, quality of bookkeeping and extent of access to bank credit is not uniformly captured or aggregated at the national level.

While DAY-NULM operational guidelines prescribe such indicators for monitoring at the ULB and State Level, their collection and use are largely decentralized and intended for local capacity building and supervision rather than for standardized national-level reporting.

(c): DAY-NULM mission concluded on 30.09.2024. There is no proposal for uniform reporting format across all states/UTs.
