TRAUMA CENTRES IN BIHAR

2263. SHRI GIRIDHARI YADAV:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the road accidents have increased significantly after improvement in road conditions including the expansion/construction of National Highways, four-lane and six-lane roads and if so, the details thereof, State-wise;
- (b) whether it is also true that a large number of injured persons die in road accidents due to the absence of trauma centres particularly in the State of Bihar; and
- (c) if so, whether the Government proposes to establish one trauma centre at each district headquarters in Bihar especially in Banka district and if so, the timeline therefor and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

(SHRI NITIN JAIRAM GADKARI)

(a) Government publishes report on "Road Accidents in India" based on data received from States/ UTs. As per the report, road accidents are multi-causal phenomenon and are the result of interplay of various factors. These can broadly be categorized into (i) human error, (ii) road condition/environment and (iii) vehicular condition.

As per the said report, State/UT-wise and year-wise details of road accidents on all category of roads and on National Highways during the calendar year 2022 to 2024 are at Annexure-I and Annexure-II, respectively.

(b) and (c) Government in Ministry of Health & Family Welfare has implemented the National Programme for Prevention & Management of Trauma and Burn Injuries (NPPMT&BI). Under the programme, total 196 Trauma Care Facilities (TCFs) were sanctioned

in Government Hospitals/ Medical Colleges across the country including 9 Trauma Care Facilities in the Bihar State. The details are as under:
