**Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:**

- (a) the salient features and objectives of the Pradhan Mantri Viksit Bharat Rozgar Yojana (PMVBRY) including its sectoral focus and employment generation target;**
- (b) the details of the registration and onboarding system for establishments and workers, including incentives for employers and digital portal integration;**
- (c) the details of implementation of PMVBRY in the State of Rajasthan, particularly the number of establishments and workers registered and employment generated in the Pali Parliamentary Constituency;**
- (d) whether the Government has developed a monitoring or assessment framework to evaluate the outcomes of the said scheme including its impact on employment levels and formal sector employment; and**
- (e) if so, the details thereof?**

**(a) to (e): The Union Cabinet, on 1 July 2025, approved the Employment Linked Incentive (ELI) Scheme, titled the Pradhan Mantri Viksit Bharat Rozgar Yojana (PMVBRY), to promote employment generation, enhance**

**employability, and strengthen social security across all sectors, with a particular focus on the manufacturing sector. The scheme was launched on 15<sup>th</sup> August 2025. The scheme has a registration period of two years from 01.08.2025 to 31.07.2027 and a budgetary outlay of ₹99,446 Crore. The scheme comprises of two parts i.e. Part A and Part B and focuses on providing support to both employees and employers by way of incentives. The scheme provides for incentives for 1.92 crore new eligible employees under Part A. Incentive for creation of approx. 2.59 crore additional jobs to employers is provided for under Part B of the scheme.**

**The Employees' Provident Fund Organisation (EPFO) is the implementing agency for the scheme. A dedicated portal ([pmvbry.epfindia.gov.in](http://pmvbry.epfindia.gov.in)) has been developed to facilitate all scheme-related processes.**

**In Rajasthan, a total of 19,975 establishments have been registered, with 1,49,349 new joinees and 3,62,144 re-joinees, including those from Pali district, as on 28.01.2026 under the Pradhan Mantri Viksit Bharat Rojgar Yojana (PMVBRY).**

**A steering committee with representation from various labour intensive and related Ministries/Departments and internal Executive committee have been constituted to ensure effective monitoring of the scheme.**
