RECRUITMENT OF SPECIALIST DOCTORS

†2510. SHRI SHIV PAL SINGH PATEL:

Will the **Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) Whether the Government is aware of the fact that the Medical College in Pratapgarh district of Uttar Pradesh has only one Emergency Medical Doctor (EMO) for Medico-Legal cases, one elderly doctor in Medicine and no faculty in Radiology, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the effective implementation of the recruitment of specialist doctors and upgradation of equipment is being carried out by the Government in the Medical College in the Pratapgarh district of Uttar Pradesh, if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has any proposal to implement a special health package for immediate staff recruitment in the Medical College in Pratapgarh district, if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether the Government is aware of the fact that there is no faculty in the Forensic Department for MBBS students in the Pratapgarh Medical College, if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) whether the Government has any proposal to implement a special package for infrastructure development for Pratapgarh Medical College, if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (c) As per the information received from the Government of Uttar Pradesh, the Autonomous State Medical College, Pratapgarh has prepared a roster for posting of Non-PG Junior Residents in the concerned clinical departments to augment the availability of doctors and ensure smooth functioning of medico-legal work. Two (02) specialist doctors in Department of Medicine and one DNB Specialist in Department of Radiology are available for treatment of

patients as well as for teaching and training of MBBS students. For upgradation of equipment, the Government of Uttar Pradesh has sanctioned ₹30.00 lakh for the Financial Year 2025–26 for procuring various equipment including Slit Lamp and C-Arm. Further, the Government of Uttar Pradesh has enhanced the remuneration to ensure effective implementation of recruitment and to attract specialist doctors/medical teachers on contract basis.

(d) & (e) The Principal of the Medical College (MD Forensic Medicine), is facilitating the training of MBBS students in the Department of Forensic Medicine and the college has advertised for recruitment of faculty in the Forensic Medicine department. Further, the state Government has sanctioned for establishment of a Nursing College, Autopsy Centre and a 100-bedded Critical Care Department within the campus of the Medical College and associated Hospital.
