SETTING UP OF NEW SHIKSHAN SANSTHA

305. SHRI KESINENISIVANATH:
SHRI B K PARTHASARATH:

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- a. the total number of New Jan Shikshan Sansthan (JSS) sanctioned and operational in the country, State/UT-wise;
- b. the details of the agencies running the JSS, State/UT-wise along with the number of people trained;
- c. the Expression of Interests that has been invited by the Government for setting up of New JSS, State/UT and district-wise for the State of Andhra Pradesh during the last five years and the current year; and
- d. whether the Government plans to establish more JSS in the country, if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP

(a) & (b): At present, 294 Jan Shikshan Sansthans (JSS) are functioning across 26 States and 7 UTs. These JSSs are registered as Non Governmental Organizations under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 for the purpose of running them. State-wise details of functional JSSs and number of trained beneficiaries are given at ***Annexure-I***. State-wise details of functional JSSs are given at ***Annexure-II***. Since the details in aforementioned Annexure-II are too lengthy. It is uploaded on Ministry's website at <https://www.msde.gov.in/documents?page=1>

Since July 2018 and till 31st December 2025, a total of 34.14 lakh beneficiaries have been trained under the JSS scheme.

(c) An Expression of Interest (EoI) to establish new Jan Shikshan Sansthans for Skill Development in the country was released on 22nd May 2023 by this Ministry, however the EoI was cancelled subsequently.

(d) At present no such proposal is under consideration.
