WORK DONE IN MAHARASHTRA UNDER AMRUT 2.0

NO. 3283. SHRI TATKARE SUNIL DATTATREY:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of water bodies approved for rejuvenation in Maharashtra along with the progress of rejuvenation till date;**
- (b) the water treatment plant capacity to be augmented in Maharashtra under AMRUT 2.0 along with the progress made till date;**
- (c) the current percentage of households with piped water supply, the updated targets under AMRUT 2.0 and the progress achieved so far in Maharashtra; and**
- (d) the number of cities that have successfully filed the City Water Balance Plans (CWBP) and City Water Action Plans (CWAP)?**

ANSWER

(a) to (d): Water is State subject. Government of India supplements the efforts of the States through schematic interventions/ advisories. It provides financial and technical support to the States through various schemes/ Missions such as Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation 2.0 (AMRUT 2.0). Under AMRUT 2.0, the States/ Union Territories are empowered to select, appraise, prioritise and implement the projects.

The State of Maharashtra has taken up 88 water body rejuvenation projects with total approved cost of ₹1463.16 crore under AMRUT 2.0. As updated by the State on AMRUT 2.0 portal, 73 projects worth ₹554.95 crore (capex) have been awarded of which works worth ₹316.09 crore have been physically completed.

The State has taken up 70 water supply projects with total approved cost of ₹10,474.68 crore for augmentation of 1829.02 Million Litre per Day (MLD) Water Treatment Plant (WTP) capacity. 64 projects worth ₹7,599.50 crore (capex) have been awarded of which works worth ₹3,627.03 crore have been physically completed.

As reported by the State, 89% of urban population (as per estimated 2021 population) is covered with household tap connections. As updated by the State on AMRUT 2.0 portal, the approved water supply projects under AMRUT 2.0 in Maharashtra cover 17.42 lakh new tap connections out of which 10,980 connections have been provided so far.

In the State of Maharashtra, 413 Urban Local Bodies have submitted City Water Balance Plans (CWBPs) on AMRUT 2.0 portal and 241 ULBs have submitted City Water Action Plans (CWAPs).
