**(a)& (b): The Ministry of Corporate Affairs is actively working with various stakeholders such as state governments, central government ministries & departments, industries and industry associations for promotion and implementation of the scheme. MCA has actively collaborated with State Government to carry out extensive Information, Education and Communication activities, including workshops, seminars, and promotional campaigns - both online and on-ground to amplify program visibility and to reach out to the target groups in various districts of the State. With active support from State Nodal Departments,**

**awareness campaigns were carried out at ITIs, Polytechnics, and graduate colleges in different districts of the country. These campaigns are being carried out for whole of the country including Dahod, Gujarat. Further, the PMIS Portal is accessible in 12 different languages to enhance inclusivity from different geographical regions of the country.**
