**BENEFICIARIES UNDER AB-PMJAY IN BIHAR**

**SHRI BAJRANG MANOHAR SONWANE:**

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government maintains updated data regarding the number of beneficiaries under the Ayushman Bharat-Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY) in Bihar, particularly in Bhagalpur district and Maharashtra, especially in aspirational districts like Beed;

(b) if so, the number of beneficiaries, Golden Cards issued and treatments provided in the country, State-wise and district-wise especially in Beed district;

(c) if not, the reasons therefor and the steps being taken by the Government to compile and make such data public; and

(d) the total number of operational District Hospitals, Sub-District Hospitals, Rural Hospitals, Primary Health Centres (PHCs) and Sub-Centres in rural areas of the country including Beed district and whether ambulance or referral transport services are provided under this scheme, if so, the details thereof?

**ANSWER**

(a) to (c): A total of 1.21 crore families are covered under Ayushman Bharat - Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY) in Bihar including 4.38 lakh families in Bhagalpur district. Further, 2.91 lakh families are covered under the scheme in Beed district of Maharashtra.

As on 28.02.2026, a total of 43.52 crore Ayushman cards have been created including 11.67 lakh cards created in the Beed district of Maharashtra. As on 31.01.2026, a total of 11.46 crore hospital admissions have been authorized under the scheme in the country and a total of 71,796 hospital admissions amounting to Rs. 158.39 crore have been authorized in the Beed district of Maharashtra. The State/UT - wise details of number of hospital admissions authorized under the scheme are given at **Annexure**.

(d): As on 28.02.2026, a total of 36,229 hospitals are empanelled under the scheme, of which 19,483 hospitals are public, including District Hospitals, Sub-District Hospitals, Rural Hospitals, Primary Health Centres. In Beed district of Maharashtra, a total of 127 hospitals are empanelled under the scheme, of which 80 are public hospitals.

Further, the scheme provides health cover of Rs. 5 lakh per family per year for secondary and tertiary care hospitalization across public and private empanelled hospitals in India. AB-PMJAY covers up to 3 days of pre-hospitalization including diagnostics, premedication, pre-anesthetic examination, and consultation relevant to the present disease and 15 days of post-hospitalization expenses including drug expenses.
