- (a) the amount of funds allocated and utilised by Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY) in the country since 2014, year-wise;
- (b) the number of vacancies in AIIMS that are filled, category-wise
- (c) the estimated cost overruns on account of delay in the construction of AIIMS projects in the country; and
- (d) the average per day in-patient admissions at AIIMS across the country, AIIMS-wise?

(a) to (d) The Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY) aims to correct regional imbalances in the availability of affordable/reliable tertiary healthcare services and also to augment facilities for quality medical education in the country. The scheme has two components, (i) setting up of All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) and (ii) upgradation of existing Government Medical Colleges/Institutions (GMCIs). Till date establishment of 22 new AIIMSs and upgradation of 75 GMCs has been approved under the scheme. Budget allocated/released under Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY) is as under:
