**FUNDS FOR CENTRAL GOVERNMENT HOSPITALS**

**3586 SHRI RAMVIR SINGH BIDHURI:**

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the total amount of funds earmarked for Central Government hospitals in Delhi in the Budget for the year 2026-27;
- (b) the details of the schemes for the expansion of Central Government hospitals in Delhi proposed in the Budget;
- (c) whether land has been made available for the expansion of AIIMS, Delhi, if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) whether the 400 acres of land vacated by the National Thermal Power Corporation (NTPC) Limited in Badarpur can be utilized for the expansion of AIIMS, if so, the details thereof?

(a) The funds allocated for Central Government Hospitals in Delhi and All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), New Delhi at Budget Estimates stage for the year 2026-27 are as under –

(b) Expansion of healthcare facilities is a functional requirement. The institutions regularly upgrade and expand their facilities. A 666-bedded Super Specialty facility is getting ready in Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia hospital. Similarly, for boosting maternal and child health services, expansion from existing 394 beds to 894 beds has been approved in Kalawati Saran Children's Hospital under the purview of Lady Hardinge Medical College.

(c) & (d) AIIMS, New Delhi has an area of 244 acres spreading over 06 land parcels including East & West Ansari Nagar, Ayur Vigyan Nagar, Masjid Moth, Trauma Centre Campus and New Hostel Complex. In addition, National Cancer Institute, established in Jhajjar as an extended campus of AIIMS, New Delhi, has a campus of 288 acres. Further, the infrastructure facilities at AIIMS are being continuously expanded and augmented to efficiently cater to the increased patient load with commissioning of several new specialty blocks like Burns & Plastic Surgery Block, Surgical Block, New Raj Kumari Amrita Kaur OPD Block, Mother & Child Block, and vertical expansion of Jai Prakash Narain Apex Trauma Centre (JPNATC). Approval has also been accorded for construction of New OPD Block at Masjid Moth Campus and 150 bedded Critical Care Block at AIIMS, New Delhi.
