**Ramsar Sites in Gujarat**

358. SHRI DHAVAL LAXMANBHAI PATEL:

Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of wetlands that have been designated as Ramsar sites in the State of Gujarat; and
- (b) the details of the financial assistance provided for the conservation and management of these wetlands during the last three years, year-wise?

(a) & (b) Four wetlands namely, Khijadia Wildlife Sanctuary, Nalsarovar, Thol Lake Wildlife Sanctuary and Wadhvana Wetland have been designated as Ramsar sites in the State of Gujarat. Based on the proposal submitted by the Government of Gujarat, an amount of Rs. 20.58 lakhs as central share has been released for the conservation and management of Khijadia Wildlife Sanctuary under the scheme of National Plan for Conservation of Aquatic Ecosystems during the last three years.
