Infrastructure Gap in AYUSH Hospitals

3641. Shri Benny Behanan:

Will the Minister of AYUSH be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has conducted any assessment of infrastructure gaps in Government Ayurveda, Homoeopathy and Siddha hospitals in Kerala, stream-wise;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether any financial assistance has been provided to such hospitals under the centrally sponsored schemes; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) to (d) Public Health being a State Subject, the primary responsibility for conducting any assessment of infrastructure gaps in Government Ayurveda, Homoeopathy and Siddha Hospitals in Kerala comes under the purview of respective State Government. However, Ministry of Ayush is implementing Centrally Sponsored Scheme of National Ayush Mission (NAM) since 2014-15 through State/UT Governments including Kerala and supporting their efforts for various activities including infrastructure upgradation of existing standalone Government Ayush Hospitals of different system as per provision of NAM guidelines. Under NAM, as reported by State Government of Kerala they have availed an amount of Rs.89.69 crores for upgradation of 130 existing Ayush Hospitals.
