- a) whether the Indian Institute of Accounting (IIA), announced in the 2022 Budget, has been scrapped and if so, the reason thereof;**
- (b) if not, the timeline and roadmap for the establishment of IIA, including the locations identified for its campuses and the expected date of commencement of academic activities;**
- (c) the objectives and unique features of the IIA compared to existing institutions offering accounting and finance education;**
- (d) the steps being taken to by the Government to collaborate with industry experts and international accounting bodies to ensure the IIA provides globally relevant education and training; and**
- (e) the estimated budget allocation for the establishment of the IIA and the status of its utilisation so far?**
