

**REVIVING TEXTILE SECTORS**

- (a) the steps taken by the Ministry to revive traditional and declining textile sectors that are facing challenges due to lack of institutional support, shortage of skilled workers and reduced market access;
- (b) the details of schemes and subsidies being provided, particularly in backward and aspirational districts, to promote revival of traditional textile clusters, including measures to integrate heritage manufacturing practices with modern machinery and technology;
- (c) the number of textile units or industries that have been revived during the last five years in the country, State-wise; and
- (d) the number of such units revived in the State of Odisha, year-wise?

**(a) & (b):** The Government has taken several steps for holistic development of traditional and textile sectors, including in backward and aspirational districts. These initiatives focus on strengthening the entire textile value chain, promoting high-growth product segments, developing modern infrastructure, enhancing skills, integrating traditional manufacturing with modern technology, and ensuring sustainable and large-scale livelihood opportunities.

To achieve these objectives, the Ministry of Textiles have implemented various schemes and initiatives across the country, including in the State of Odisha. The major schemes/initiatives include PM Mega Integrated Textile Regions and Apparel (PM MITRA) Parks Scheme, which seeks to create modern, integrated and world-class textile infrastructure; Production Linked Incentive (PLI) Scheme focusing on Man Made Fibre (MMF) Fabric, MMF Apparel and Technical Textiles to boost large-scale manufacturing and enhance competitiveness; National Technical Textiles Mission focusing on Research, Innovation & Development, Promotion and Market Development; SAMARTH – Scheme for Capacity Building in Textile Sector with the objective of providing demand-driven, placement-oriented skilling programmes; Silk Samagra-2 for comprehensive development of the sericulture value chain; and the National Handloom Development Programme for end-to-end support to the handloom sector. The Ministry of Textiles has also undertaken the National Handicrafts Development Programme and the Comprehensive Handicrafts Cluster Development Scheme for promotion of handicraft artisans. Under these schemes, support is provided for marketing, skill development, cluster development, direct benefit to artisans, infrastructure creation and technology upgradation.

**(c) & (d):** As per Annual Surveys of Industry, Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation (MoSPI), State/UT-wise total number of textiles & apparel factories and number of operational factories is attached at **Annexure-I**. No proposal for revival of textile units has been received from the State Governments during the last five years.
