DEVELOPMENT OF AIRPORTS UNDER UDAN SCHEME

4375. MR PATHAN YUSUF

Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION

be pleased to state:-

- (a) the number of airports developed under the UDAN scheme that are currently functional, State-wise;
- (b) the amount (in Rupees) spent on developing each of these airports, airport-wise;
- (c) the average annual cost for maintenance and upkeep of each of these airports, airportwise;
- (d) the average number of flights operated per week from each of these airports and the number of airlines operating from these airports, airport-wise; and
- (e) the average annual number of passengers travelling from these airports, airport-wise?

ANSWER

Minister of State in the Ministry of CIVIL AVIATION (Shri Murlidhar Mohol)

(a) to (c): Under the Regional Connectivity Scheme - Ude Desh ka Aam Nagrik (RCS-UDAN), as on 28.02.2026, 95 unserved and underserved airports (including 17 heliports and 02 water aerodromes) have been developed and operationalised. The State-wise details, along with the expenditure incurred, are placed at Annexure. There is no provision under the UDAN Scheme for the maintenance and upkeep of airports.

(d) & (e): As on 28.02.2026, a total of 663 routes have been operationalised, carrying over 162 lakhs domestic passengers on more than 3.41 lakh RCS flights under the Regional Connectivity Scheme- Ude Desh ka Aam Nagrik (RCS-UDAN).
